Applications will be reviewed by an international selection committee in a 2-step procedure.

The LOIs that will be admitted to the second step will submit by mail to the WSF office info@worldsclerofound.org the whole project for evaluation before midnight, February the 1st, 2023

Funding available: a total amount of 500,000 EU will be split for two winners of 250.000 EU for each project

The winners of the grants will be requested to use the funds within 3 years. The PI will must present the final or preliminary results at the opening ceremony of the World Congress on Systemic Sclerosis in 2024 in Prague.

Eligibility criteria:

- The PI-lead investigator must hold a position at an academic institution during the duration of the project: the applicant needs to demonstrate that the required infrastructure is available to carry out the proposed research.
- Applicants/ host institutions must be diligent in ensuring the signed terms and conditions are returned by the stated deadline. It should be noted that this is a condition for funding.
